#### **28 May**

Release of Vilma 2.7.0 and the first day you can submit files according to a new version for approval at Finfo.

#### 2 September

This day is the deadline for the introduction of Vilma 2.7.0. This applies to both suppliers (information providers) and retailers (information recipients). If you have not changed the version by this time, you will be temporarily suspended from the Vilma flow until the upgrade has been made.



## Hands-on, Transition Management – Supplier (Information Provider)

 Notify to Finfo that you are ready to test and to get your files approved (Declaration) for Vilma 2.7.0 by filling out this form;

- Then send your article file according the regular handling to Finfo,
- Finfo Checks your information and will let you know if anything is missing or needs to be changed in order to get approved
- Finfo will notify you when you are approved for the new version

# New information fields, background



Focus Biocides and SCIP numbers – legal requirements

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CHEMISTRY

Here we often see that things go wrong, the subject is difficult and in many cases it is difficult to interpret legal requirements.

Think about who is it in your organization that can answer to this questions, or if you need to request information from suppliers or subcontractors.





#### **BIOCIDES**

For example, it can be disinfectant, mosquito repellent, work of the control of t

Biocidal products that act chemically or biologically are covered by biocidal legislation.

Biocidal products, on the other hand, that act in a physical or mechanical manner are not covered by the rules on biocides. A mechanical mousetrap is an example of such a product not covered.






## **BIOCIDES**

In order to sell biocides, the trade needs to have access to the product's registration number and, if there is one, the date when the resale prohibition for the product occurs.

Different requirements in Sweden or if the product is approved within the EU by ECHA.






When the purpose of the treatment is to give the product a function, for example, to make a sports shirt odorless or a cutting board antibacterial.

Other examples of goods that may be treated are building materials, boats painted with special boat bottom color to protect from algae and shells, impregnated wood, shoes, mattresses, cleaning materials and more.

## **BIOCIDES-treated article**

A biocide-treated article is an article that has been treated with a type of pesticide, a so-called biocidal product.

There is requirements for labelling and information on the product, but it is also important for e-commerce, customers should be able to make a conscious choice at the time of purchase.





## **SCIP-number**

From January 5<sup>th</sup> 2021, manufacturers, importers and distributors of articles must notify

the presence of substances of very high concern in their articles

to the so-called SCIP database of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).





## Who should report to SCIP?

The following suppliers of goods within the EU must notify the SCIP database:


- manufacturers
- importers
- distributors

A company that imports goods from a country outside the EU/EEA is an importer.

A company that buys a product from a supplier within the EU is counted as a distributor if the company resupplies the product.

Lego manufactures, fitters and subcontractors are also examples of suppliers covered by the rules.





## **SCIP Number at Registration**

# Refer to information submitted by someone else

The retailer, the next recipient down the supply chain, will normally refer to information that someone else has already submitted to SCIP, through so-called Simplified SCIP notification.

# The referral requires a pre-existing SCIP number

("Simplified SCIP Notification") and referral ("Referencing").





#### **GLN** = **Global Location Number**

- We are introducing GS1 identifiers for contract parties and locations in Vilma
- The first step will be to identify your company as a provider of information
- In future versions, we will probably introduce more options to identifications, such as which GLN you use for orders in an EDI flow
- We will also phase out the number we currently use to identify a provider of information

A biocide-treated article is not the same thing as being covered by the biocidal legislation where the article contains biocide.

Addition	Date of resale prohibition	Resale prohibition can be of two types; permanently or temporarily.  When the prohibition is <b>permanent</b> a status code for outgoing handling must also be filled in.  When the prohibition is <b>temporary</b> without outgoing handling then the date is removed when there is no longer a resale prohibtion.  Biocidal products that are no longer allowed to be sold by the retail are seen as a permanent ban on resale. The date on which the biocidal product may no longer be sold in the trade must be indicated.	To be submitted when dates are available	The retailers removes the product from the assortment on this date and no longer sells to its customers. The deleted is either permanent or temporary.
Addition	SCIP- number 1 and 2	Enter the article's SCIP number if it is subject to SVHC legislation.	Mandatory to indicate whether the article is covered by the SVHC legislation	The retailers uses the SCIP number as a signal to apply for the SCIP number for the item, which is a legal requirement for sales.



Should there be more countries that are still relevant, the country where the trade has the greatest value in terms of market value in knowing is stated.  In future versions of Vilma, we are reviewing the possibility of being able to specify several countries so that the picture of manufacturing countries is complete.






## Biocidal product, Registered where?

Indicate whether the article is a biocidal product by stating where the product is registered.

1=Sweden

2= Other country



#### **Biocid class**

Stated if the item is registered in Sweden.
Biocide class, if available, determines who can buy the product. Ensures the right handling in sales or via e-commerce.

#### Is the article biocid treated?

Always indicated by 1 or 0.

1 = Yes

0 = No








#### SCIP number 1 and 2

Indicates whether the article is covered by the SVHC legislation.

Use SCIP number 2 for e.g. a package of two products that have different SCIP or if the packaging itself has its own SCIP number.



#### Resale prohibition date

Specify when the item may not be sold any more. The date is the first day the item may not be sold. The date can be permanent or temporary.

#### Effective sale price date

Stated if the selling price is stated.

Does the retail need to take batch into account when selling?

Always indicated by 1 or 0.

Specified if the item is temperature sensitive. Minimum storage temperature in degrees Celsius.

#### **KNSLUEPDDA**

20250228

#### Last valid date of EPD

Stated if the article has an EPD.
